BIG DADDY BOY inside early, moved out around the turn, rallied and while no match for the winner saved second. SCALDING HOT carried in by WILLOUGHBY at the break, was back early, rallied outside and was late for second. POLY SAUCE forced in at the break, was straightened, came three wide around the turn, loomed a threat, then gave way. MOONLIGHT STOCK was outrun. WILLOUGHBY lugged in at the break bothering inner foes, was not a threat. HE'S ON CALL vied for the lead to the turn, then weakened. T Z TOP was always back.
