BONESINABOX was away alertly, was taken back, angled out on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, closed willingly and drew off past the eighth pole. PRINCE WILLIAM B stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, dueled to mid stretch and yielded to finish second best. TAUPHINE PASS rallied around the turn, angled out in the upper stretch and got up for show. GOHEADMAKEMYDAY saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn to get within striking distance and came up empty late. LITE UP MY DREAM was jostled at the start, raced inside to turn, offered a mild bid only and did not menace. SEVEN MILE BRIDGE was not a factor. BAD FOOTED GRADY broke out, vied to mid stretch and faltered. SIR SULLY was crowded at the start and outrun.
