MATOU unhurried early from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive, dueled through the drive and inched clear late. GOOSEY well placed early from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure and was just up for the place. TREY J. outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded along the rail but was outfinished for the place. MAGIC RIDGE forced the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. A P AGAIN chased the early pace outside but could only improve position. DRAKE'S LASER chased the early pace and tired. TOO MUCH SAUCE was no factor. SIR SOXS was no threat. UNCLE R D pressed the early pace and tired. THREE LEGGED away in good order from the inside, gained the early margin, held a clear margin up the backstretch, remained forward through the second turn then gave way. This race was hand timed
