Footnotes

BAD AND TOUGH dueled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, was engaged by KENZIE'S HEAT entering the second turn, battled with that one through the second turn, dropped back slightly at the eighth pole, responded to pressure to come again and was just up the final stride. KENZIE'S HEAT dueled from the outside early, dropped back up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn, dueled with the winner through the second turn, gained a short margin at the eighth pole but could not last. MAVS A. P. outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and had good energy late. TOUGH DAY forced the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly up the backstretch, responded entering the drive but could only improve position. LE PRINCE was no factor. WALK THE TANGO vied early from the inside and tired. RAINBOWMOON showed little.
