ORPHAN BRIGADE vied for the lead while racing three wide on the backstretch, was in a long sustained drive throughout then dug in gamely in the stretch to be best in the end. COREY'S RED BOY vied for the lead from the inside, stayed inside on the turn then dug in gamely throughout the stretch but was no match in late stretch. MARKET ICE was settled then moved up to be five wide into the turn, made a strong bid in the middle of the turn to reach contention then raced evenly in the stretch and was no menace. SINISTER threw his head at the start then was unhurried early, rallied on the turn while three wide and moved out to be five wide but lacked a closing response in the end. NOWURTAKN was inside and saving ground on the turn then failed to menace in the stretch. EARTHQUAKE was unhurried early while racing inside into the turn, saved ground on the turn but was no threat. SEATTLE SKATER vied for the lead from between rivals on the backstretch, was used up and gave way in the stretch. CHANGE OF ORDERS was four wide on the run down the backstretch, was through after a half and stopped then was being eased up in late stretch.
