KY SUNNY CAT forwardly placed along the inside, slipped through inside BOONE'S GOLD SLEW in upper stretch, closed gamely and prevailed. BAD JOHN out footed early, bid four wide nearing the drive, took over a furlong out but was outfinished. CHECK WITH ME allowed to settle, rallied four wide for the drive and then while no match for the top two was game for the show. BOONE'S GOLD SLEW vied for the lead to upper stretch and then weakened late. MAN O' MIGHTY was outrun. J'S SMOKING COIN lugged in at the break and was not a factor. MR. SLADE was no real threat. RATTY TATTY WALK trailed to the drive and showed little. BLACK HAWK UP hustled up from between foes to gain the edge, stopped badly.
