Footnotes

SIR SULLY dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was well clear late while kept to task. BETTER BEE LUCKY stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. MYSTICAL FRIEND up close early from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but could only gain the show. FIESTY GERALD broke well from between foes to gain

the early margin, dueled through the turn, remained forward entering the drive but had nothing left. D C SILVER broke well from the outside, drifted out early, bothered COHEN'S BANDITO, chased the pace but could only improve position. After a Stewards' Inquiry D C SILVER was disqualified for interference. IOUTTABEENASAINTE forced the early pace and tired. FIRST DOWN CORY could only pass tired ones. SMART DOENY was no factor. KISSERL IS MY NAME was no threat. SINNERON stumbled at the start and was no threat. BAYLOR'S RODEO was never close. CASEY'S A REBEL showed little. COHEN'S BANDITO broke well from the outside, clipped heels and fell and walked off.
