Footnotes

LITTLE DUMPLING devoid of early foot, circled rivals while rallying around the second turn, took over the lead approaching mid stretch and held SASSY R. T. safe. SASSY R. T. allowed to settle, circled rivals for the drive and closed late. TONY DEE'S GIRL moved to the rail to race close up and had no rally. NATIVE WAVE saved ground much of the trip and improved position. ONE DEAL FOR ALL saved ground until the drive, swung out and passed tiring rivals. HELEN'S HUNGARIAN never far back, came up empty. GENUINE GIRL sprinted clear around the first turn and faltered badly once overtaken. LIL MISS GABI raced close up for a half and gave way. BRIDGE DANCE had no speed and was not a threat. FAST WIN off last, hustled to the rail entering the first turn, gave way after a half.
