NORTHERN ACRE vied for the lead between foes, shook clear before the drive and then held on. J. C.'S SIDEOATS crossed to the rail while outrun, remained inside to rally but was too late. EXPRESSIVE WORD angled to the inside before the turn, eased out in the lane and closed mildly. DYNAMIC DIVA vied between foes early, eased back before the turn, bid four wide but could make little impact. THRILLING REQUEST hustled up from the rail to contest the pace, faded. DEAL ME THE MOON vied for the lead while four wide until midway around the turn and weakened. SLADE'S BAYOU was never dangerous.
