CALIPARI'S KITTEN was allowed to settled in the early going, rallied on the far turn while three wide, was in a hard drive then drew away in late stretch. DO THE CONGA dueled for the early lead while two wide, drew off on the far turn then was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. WHAT SECRET stalked the early pace while racing three wide then rallied on the far turn making a strong bid to upper stretch then flattened out in the end. NERVES OF STEEL was allowed to settle in the early going, rallied four wide on the far turn to upper stretch and made a mild gain in the stretch. SOVEREIGN DAY was inside and saving ground on the far turn then failed to respond in the stretch drive. BIG DRIVE was allowed to settle then failed to respond. BUG MAN set the early pressured pace from the inside then dueled for the lead, was used up and gave way on the far turn. ONLY THE STRONG chased the early pace while three wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered.
