READY AND WILD dueled from the inside, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole to gain a clear margin and was clear late while kept to task. POMEROSA PROSPECT stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive and was getting to the winner late. LITE UP MY DREAM well placed from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not keep pace. GORDY BOY outrun early, could only pass tired ones. SALTWATER BOY dueled from the inside and tired. WE ADORE THEODORE was no factor. JOHN LOUIS CLASSIC was no threat.
