MAKETHEBANK stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded to gain a clear margin mid stretch and was clear late while kept to task. JET SET DOT well placed from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded when asked but was no match for the winner. I. M. A. GIFT chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the turn and finished well. MARDI GRAS LADY dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn, drifted in and out through the drive and tired late. LOVER IN A STORM dueled from the inside early, remained engaged through the turn but tired in the drive. POOF SHE'S GONE dueled from between foes early, chased the pace entering the turn, responded entering the drive, was steadied mid stretch and had nothing left. A LITTLE BOSSIE had a steady fade. FINEST VELVET was always outrun.
