EURO CASH well placed from the inside, dropped back slightly, responded along the rail and closed well but was outfinished. MAJOR CASE far back early, advanced outside, responded entering the drive but was outfinished for the show. PLACID STREAM forced the early pace from the outside but could not keep pace. WILDCAT LOVE was no factor. QUAZAR chased the early pace and tired. SEA THE SOLDIER trailed throughout.
