BROADWAY KING broke sharp from between foes to gain the early margin, remained clear entering the turn, held a clear margin entering the drive then was all out to last. ZIP MOTION chased the early pace from the outside, dropped back slightly entering the turn, responded to pressure and was getting to the winner. SAINT MARDI GRAS chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. KNOCKYA LIGHTS OUT went evenly. DEHERE'S THE GRAY was no factor. VOODO VODKA chased the early pace and tired. JADE TRADER showed little and was eased to the wire.
