Footnotes

POWERFULLY dueled for the early lead while two wide, was well handled then drew off in mid stretch and was clearly much the best in the end. ALL STAR COLTON rallied three wide on the turn, was gaining ground but was no match for the winner in late stretch. SMELLINSMOKE dueled for the early lead from the inside, was hard used on the turn then weakened in mid stretch. SOCCER PRINCE was three wide on the turn then swung out to be six wide in upper stretch then made a mild gain in late stretch. BE A DEACON was allowed to settle then rallied five wide in the stretch and made a mild gain in the end. DANGER INTENTION was unhurried early then rallied three wide in the stretch but was no menace in the stretch. BYGONE'S PFANCI was well placed while inside, saved ground on the turn then lacked a rally in the stretch. MARDI GRAS MAN was inside early on then squeezed and shuffled back then rallied two wide in the middle of the turn but flattened out in the drive. MILLER GROVE was unhurried early while racing three wide on the turn and failed to menace. G. G.'S EL JEFE rallied four wide on the turn making a bid then gave way in the stretch.
