BIGIN dueled from the outside early, remained forward entering the turn, responded when asked entering the drive and inched clear late. DAISY BOY stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, responded to split rivals mid stretch and was just up for the place. BODACIOUS GIFT off a step slow, advanced inside entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and was gaining late. DIXIE ALL DAY dueled from the inside early, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive but could not keep pace. START A RUMOR could only improve position. PINECREST PIRATE chased the early pace outside and tired. GOLDEN GRAMMAR was no factor. HEZA SHINING HOUR was no threat. STRIPES AND STARS showed little.
