DIRECT ZIP unhurried early from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded but could not match strides with the winner. AUNTIE'S KITCHEN dueled from the inside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. PANCHO PUDDLES well placed from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but could only go evenly late. BARBSWHODAT chased the early pace but had nothing left. BREONS GOLD was no factor. THAT SILVER forced the early pace outside and tired. MACARONI'S DEELITE dueled from the outside early and gave way. BOOM BOOM DYNAMITE was finished after a half.
