ANASHEED CLASS raced wide and got up for the show. BEGG'S out footed early, moved up around the turn and then had no final kick. CITY WIN devoid speed, showed late interest. AFLEET TRICK forwardly placed to the drive, weakened. SOME DUDE forwardly placed to the drive, then gave way. SEBULBA was outrun. MIMI'S CHOICE reluctant to load, was not a threat. EL TAPIDERO well back to the drive, was not a factor. PENCHING PENNIES showed little.
