WET BOTTOM dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, gained a clear margin entering the second turn, widen the advantage at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. MISS NATXO outrun early, steadily advanced inside, altered outside for the drive and was getting to the winner. RAINY SEASON dueled from the outside early, battled up the backstretch, remained in a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. IZ R A ZEDE went evenly. THATDARKBEAUTY chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. DARLING BID was no factor. LADY MISSILE had little interest. RAVANUSA was never close.
