CAJUN PERSUASION dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole then just lasted late. GUT CHECK stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and was getting to the winner. PORT OF SEATTLE far back early from the inside, advanced entering the turn, made a bid along the rail and closed well late. HAWAIIAN CHOICE chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward but could only go evenly late. TUPELO PLAYBOY could only improve position. HEZALOTTA WANDA was no factor. EASY JAZZ dueled from the inside and tired. EDNA'S RADE was squeezed back at the start, rushed up then tired in the drive. WILD REECE was no threat. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
