IDEFROMTHEBAYOU chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, made a bid to gain a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. AFRICAN GRAY stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked but could not reach the winner. TIGHT GRIP forced the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded but could not keep pace. WILLIST outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, made a bid and finished well. FISH CAKES could only improve position. AND MUSIC CAME broke sharp from the inside to set the early pace then tired in the drive. LEMON SHERBERT chased the early pace and tired. MAJOR PRINCE was no factor. TENSAS CANEBRAKE had a steady fade. LITTLE DOLLAR was finished early.
