MIDNIGHT HEIST well placed early from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was along in time. ROCKET TO THE SKY stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and finished even for the place. DYNAMIC RESOURCE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but tired late while finishing even for the place. SKYMAX dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but had nothing left. RODEO RASCAL went evenly. SOLDIER ON GO pressed the early pace from the outside but had no late response. EASY DANCER was no factor. SOUTH WEST TARGET was no threat. MATIAS was never close. SIBERIAN MAN broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, bolted entering the first turn and lost rider.
