Footnotes

YUKON BANDIT pressed the early pace while racing three wide on the turn, was in a long hard drive and gained command in late stretch and proved best in the end. ALL WIRED UP set a pressured pace from the inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. DELTA WHIRL was steadied off heels of ALL WIRED UP soon after the start then was in tight heading into the turn, saved ground on the turn then started a run along the inside and tried to slip through but was squeezed nearing the furlong marker and then angled out to be three wide in late stretch but was outfinished for the place in the end. FASS FEAT raced four wide on the turn making a bid then flattened out in the drive. CALL ME COLLECT raced three wide on the turn then was no menace in the stretch drive. DAVY'S PRODUCTION raced on the inside on the turn then lacked a rally in the stretch drive. CHOCTAW PRINCE broke slowly from the gate and trailed throughout.
