ACE AND THE QUEEN in tight early, moved out around the turn, rallied mid track and won going away. POMEROSA PROSPECT stalked CECIL JOHN down the backstretch, took over before the drive, then was no match for the winner late. STEVENDER unhurried, showed late interest. DOO WAP DADDY inside early, was steered out before the turn, came five wide around the turn and then could make little impact. POLITICAL ROCK well back to before the drive, improved position. CANDIANO out footed, loomed three wide around the turn, then failed to sustain his bid. HAILEY ALL WIRE UP was outrun. FIRES OF FUJI was never dangerous. COCKY AND BOLD was no real threat. CECIL JOHN clear early, was headed approaching the drive and then faltered. CRANKEY CORNERS showed early foot, then gave way. MARKET ICE was outrun. MAX'STWICE raced wide. STUBBORN HEART forwardly placed for a half, stopped.
