Footnotes

LISTENTOTHEODOCTOR dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive and inched clear late. CURESMYBLUES dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not match strides. DE DREAMER well placed from the outside, responded entering the drive but could only gain the show. WEAR THE STORM could only pass tired ones. NIGHT CALL pressed the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, reached a forward position entering the drive, drifted in mid stretch then tired. TRIPLE K PRINCESS broke slow, rushed up to chase the early pace, advanced entering the drive, was steadied when in tight and had nothing left. SHANALINO forced the early pace outside and tired.
