LOVEABLE DAVIS drifted into BEN'S DR. DAN after the break, was straightened, moved to the inside while unhurried, continued inside to rally, got clear before the final sixteenth and then held on. MOSLEY settled off the rail, rallied mid track but was too late. AXE FACTOR close up, moved out for the drive and was game for the show. DIXIE SLEW four wide early, bid outside JOHNNY COME LATELY before the turn, remained a threat to mid stretch and then weakened late. JOHNNY COME LATELY vied for the lead, got clear nearing mid stretch but then faltered late. NO ANTE came in at the break brushing BEN'S DR. DAN, was outrun to the drive and came wide in the drive. BEN'S DR. DAN brushed from both sides at the break, was no real threat. WHY WOULDNTU POPS was always back. TUXEDO BUCK trailed.
