MAGIC FORTY WON broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and proved best while kept to task. ORO SENORITA chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. MISS LILLIS stalked the early pace from the inside, made a bid along the rail but could only gain the show. QUILTING QUEEN pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn and finished well but too late. KRUZINFORKRYSTON forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. CASUAL GRAY went evenly. AUDACIOUS LINDA chased the early pace and tired. GO LILAH GO was no factor. PRIVATE IDE was no threat. SQUIRREL was always outrun.
