STONE KEEPER dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. MARDISGRAS TOY stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, responded when asked but was no match for the winner while gaining the place. CHICOT BAY stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded to pressure and

closed well late. FORTY MORE WINS chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and finished well. HUFFS MR. BIGGS dueled from the inside early, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but tired late. SOCIALLYCHALLENGED could only improve position. DA WHO DAT PRINCE went evenly. BLAKE'S REVENGE forced the early pace from the outside, dueled through the turn then tired in the drive. TRIBUTE OF GOLD could only pass tired ones. PREAPPROVED was no factor. MAOTAI had a steady fade. POP DARBONNE was no threat. KELLYS NEXT STORM showed little. DIABLO ACT was finished early and eased at the finish and walked off.
