CAYENNE NATIVE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and held sway. MONTY LIGHTNING stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. SENSATION EARL dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. HEZA WALTZIN chased the early going from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded and finished well. ROYALEE BRED could only improve position. CAPTAIN AUSTIN forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. RAIL'S GENUINE BOY was no factor. RAHY BALBOA had a steady fade. WOOTSIE WHO was no threat. GOLDEN ETBAUER had little interest. AFTERNOON RUNAWAY was always outrun.
