CUPID'S HIT stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, dueled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive and drew clear late. SWIFTY UNEAUX chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn but could not reach the winner. GEORGIA GLITTER dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. RICHMAR forced the early pace from between foes, made a bid but was too late. BONESINABOX was no real factor. NUN LIKE ME dueled from between foes and tired. FREEDOM RUN dueled from the inside and gave way.
