ANCHORED BACK stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked to gain the margin deep stretch and was well clear while kept to task. SCOOTA PETE chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, dropped back, responded but could only gain the place. LEADPIPEINCH up close early from the outside, chased the early pacesetter up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. TOUGH AS STEEL dueled for the early lead from the inside, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn then tired in the drive. KENSETH was no factor. HOURCHANGINGFUTURE trailed throughout.
