BUD IS CHOICE unhurried in the early part, made a late bid, racing five wide and finished willingly. BIG DRIVE was an early factor, forwardly placed throughout and put forth a game effort. BULIMINELLA GOLD raced near the back in the beginning, while saving ground, made a bid and hung. MARDI GRAS MAN raced in the middle of the pack and put forth an even effort. SHERIFF'S BIG GUN went to the front, drove clear and faded. HIGHHOPESEDELIGHT lacked early speed and showed little. JONES FOCUS raced within contention and faded. RED HOT ASSASSIN always raced in the back, was no threat and pulled up down the home stretch.
