ECLETO RED was inside and stalking the early pace, rallied on the turn then moved out to be three wide in upper stretch, angled back to the inside in mid stretch and powered to the front in late stretch and was best in the end. PHANTOM'S GHOST was unhurried early then rallied and moved out to be seven wide for the stretch drive, closed willingly on the outside and was along for the place in the end. MATOU was saved ground on the turn then rallied along the inside in the stretch and finished well in the end. K ONE KOBRA was four wide on the turn then made a bid five wide in the stretch but was no menace in the en. COLE'S MAGIC VOW was three wide into the turn then made a bid but bore in slightly near the quarter pole, gained a slim lead in mid stretch but faltered in the stretch drive. THWART was unhurried early then made a mild rally while six wide in the stretch but was no menace in the end. MUST HAVE was two wide on the turn then rallied and made a four wide bid to mid stretch but flattened out in the end. KWIK N' SMOKEY was chasing the early pace while two wide, bore out nearing the quarter pole and was taken up off heels then dropped back quickly and lacked a rally in the stretch. COAL MINER CHARLIE was hustled along to set a pressured pace from the inside, was used up then gave way.
