HARRIET POTTER raced within striking distance, made a bid down the stretch, drove clear and won under urging. WILD BRE BRE sprinted clear, led until deep in the final stretch, couldn't match strides with the winner, but was a clear second. BRICK GATE raced within contention, forwardly placed throughout and lacked a late kick. SARAH'S RIVER GIRL pressed the early pace and weakened. AWESOME GRACE raced near the back and put forth an even effort. HUFFS MISS BIGGS lacked early speed and was never a threat. ZOPEDO raced near the middle of the field and retreated. PRINCESS ROYALTY void of early speed and was always back.
