WILL BE FLEET vied between foes down the backstretch, shook clear inside the final furlong and proved clearly best. PROUD ABBY reserved early, raced inside around the turn, angled out for the drive and then lacked the needed finish. STRIKING AUDREY raced inside to the turn, moved out before the drive and then closed late. BEHLER'S BEAUTY devoid speed, showed late interest. SAINT OR SINNER forwardly placed, loomed three wide entering the turn and then faded in the lane. TATUM GIRL vied for the lead from the inside, gained the edge approaching the turn, remained a threat until before mid stretch and then faltered inside the final furlong. ZARB'S ROSE slow away, was no real threat. GO MISS BAG raced wide while outrun. MISSION FOR BAG showed little.
