Footnotes

TOO TOO FULUSH dueled from the inside for the early lead, shook loose entering the turn, widen the advantage at the eighth pole and was never threatened while in hand throughout. A LITTLE BOSSIE stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded along the rail and was just up for the place. SWEETER TWITTER well placed from the outside, remained forward for the drive but was outfinished for the place. VIVA ROSITA dueled from the outside early, held a forward position entering the turn but could not keep pace. GRAND PRINCESS forced the early pace inside but had nothing left. WEDDING SLIPPERS chased the early pace and tired. WASHINGTON NIGHT hesitated at the start and was no factor. SEFA'S PYE showed little.
