DROOLIN JO JO pressed the pace, racing five wide around the first turn, took command down the backside and proved the best. REGAL ROSSINI raced within contention and followed the winner to the wire. MR. ANDREW pressed the pace, steadied down the backside, blocked, angled out, entered the home stretch three wide and was a clear third. TONY BOY raced near the back in the early part, showed late interest, but was no factor. THE A. C. MAN void of early speed, improved position, but was no threat. AFTERNOONATWHITEYS raced within striking distance and faded. CAJUN GENTLEMEN went to the front, drove clear and was finished early. BIG W'S LA TEE always raced near the back and showed little. DUTCH BREW vied for the early advantage and stopped.
