TIME IS CRUCIAL settled off the rail, moved up approaching the drive, bid outside the leaders in mid stretch, then proved clearly best. FRIENDLY POCKET saved ground early, advanced around the second turn, split foes for the drive, bid then was out kicked. FOXWOOD RUNNER raced wide and was along for the show. IDE BALL reserved early, rallied along the rail around the second turn, awaited room approaching the drive, was steered out to rally, then could make little impact. POPPA DUKE set a pressured pace, then faltered late. YUKON BANDIT settled off the leaders, then had no response. PINECREST BOY was outrun. OKIE SOUVENIR vied for the lead, then gave way inside the final furlong. SMARTY DIAMOND was never dangerous.
