CATCH THE BUSS out footed early, hustled up after ERL GIRL around the turn, then could not overtake that one. SUGAR PUSH settled off the rail, continued out and gout up for the show. CAROLINA LADY inside to the drive, moved out and could make little impact. IDE COST PENNIES out footed early, advanced between foes. MISS SCARFACE out footed early, moved to the inside, then had no late response. MOTOROLA JADE raced wide. HOLY FOREVER steadied early before the turn and was not a threat. AIDEN'S AFFAIR hustled up around the turn, then faltered. SIRAH SIRAH in tight early, had a rail trip. HIGH ON AIR raced wide. JULIES CARNIVAL was always back.
