Footnotes

SALT MOUNTAIN restrained from early on, was eased out once entering the backstretch, advanced nearing the second turn, split foes turning for home, then prevailed. HOLY BLUE three wide around both turns, ranged up before the drive, gained the edge nearing mid stretch, then was no match for the winner late. BRANDON'S TROPHY brushed by BECKWITH STREET early, raced close up, loomed between foes around the second turn, gained the edge, got headed and then weakened late. HE'S A SLEWVESCENT inside to the drive, moved out and was no real threat. BECKWITH STREET bumped and forced in by HEZA STROM CAT at the break, raced back around the first turn, made a quick three wide move to gain a clear lead, was headed around the second turn, then faltered. HEZA STORM CAT lugged in at the break bothering inner foes, moved clear early around the first turn, was overtaken before a half, then dropped back. MANNING forwardly placed early, dropped back around the second turn and was eased.
