DIVINE PROVIDENCE dueled for the early lead, pulled away down the stretch and proved the best. CARMEN'S MYSTERY challenged for the early advantage, racing between rivals, eased back around the turn, angled out, came again, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. BELLE ROSA TRIBUTE flashed early speed, forwardly placed throughout, but proved no match for the winner. LUCKED OUT lacked early speed, improved position, but was no factor. HIGHSTEEPIN GATE raced within striking distance, faded and finished evenly near the back. FLASHY MAXINE always raced near the back and was never a factor. TERRIFIC INDY trailed the field and was outrun.
