MR BARRETTE RUN unhurried in the early part, moved up, four wide around the turn and drove clear. TWINSTORM pressed the pace, raced three wide around the turn, couldn't match strides with the winner, but held on for second. DAPPLE DOWN broke slow, moved up, raced in the middle of the field, made a late bid and was outfinished for second. CLASSY SUAVE raced near the back, made a mild bid, racing four wide, but was no factor. SOUTHERN FLING pressed the early pace and faded. CAMELOT DE CAT went to the front, drove clear and was finished early. DREAM IN SILVER showed early speed and retreated. DIXIE DOT RUN always raced near the back and was no threat.
