LONE STAR SIZZLER sprinted to front, drove clear and was kept to the task. MY FRIEND TAG pressed the pace, forward throughout, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. BATTLIN BILL raced within striking distance, made a wide bid, but proved no match for the top two. GO BABY BOY raced in the middle of the field, made a mild bid, but was no factor. PINECREST PIRATE raced in the middle of the field and put forth an even effort. COOLCIDEUP pressed the early pace, saved ground and faded. SIMPLY HEATH broke poorly and lacked a bid. MR. CARL E. always raced near the back and was no threat. DONNER'S CHOICE broke poorly and was never close.
