TOO DIM unhurried in the early part, made a late rally, racing four wide and was going away at the end. DIXIE ALL DAY raced within striking distance, made a late bid, but proved no match for the winner. REECE'S WILDCAT vied for the early lead, drove clear, but couldn't keep up with the top two. MUST HAVE void of early speed, made a late gain and was outfinished for third. DAISY BOY raced near the middle of the field, made a mild bid, but was no factor. LEES STONE raced in the middle of the pack and put forth an even effort. ROLL OF THE DICE raced within striking distance and lacked a late bid. MR. ERIN challenged for the early lead and faded. SPECIAL STONE lacked early speed and was never a threat. STONEWALL SURPRISE raced near the back and showed little. WILDCAT RADE showed early speed and stopped.
