EL'S CITY BOY reserved early, moved to the inside before the turn, angled out for the drive, rallied determinedly and proved clearly best. THINGS THAT FLY close up, bid three wide for the drive, took over in upper stretch and then was no match late. ISABELLA SYMPHONEY raced wide and got up for the show. THE PRINCIPAL MAN trailed to the drive, rallied outside and closed mildly. WHISTLIN' OMEN forwardly placed, bid approaching mid stretch and then had no final kick. FAST FASHION was never dangerous. KAHUNA NINE stalked STORM CHANNEL down the backstretch, got clear around the turn and then gave way once overtaken. STORM CHANNEL vied for the lead from the inside and then dropped back once displaced.
