BOREGO'S BARBARIAN challenged for the early lead, forwardly placed throughout, drove clear and won under steady urging. QUICK TEMPERED raced within contention, saved ground around the turn, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. BYE BROWNIE went to the front, drove clear and lacked a late rally. MAYBE LOCO raced near the middle of the field, made a mild bid, but was no factor. COOPED UP raced within striking distance, weakened and finished evenly. CROWNFORABLESSING lacked early speed, came around the turn four wide and was no threat. LE PRINCE void of early speed and was never a factor. MIDBARS T. J. raced in the middle of the pack and faded. HINTOFFPERFECTION reared at the start and was never close. THANKS DOCTOR JOHN pressed the early pace and retreated.
