SCORPION PLACE unhurried early, steadily advanced outside, reached a striking position entering the second turn, made a bid to duel through the drive and outfinished rivals the final strides. TOUGH ISSIE stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to duel through the drive but was outfinished. LUCKYLILGOLDDIGGER stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, lacked room entering the drive, altered outside but was outfinished. INDIAN TREATY chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid and finished well. BAYOU ROAD forced the early pace outside but had nothing left. PRIVATE NATIVE dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the second turn then tired. A RUNNIN DREAM chased the early pace inside and tired. PHILOSOPHER was no factor. WHODABABYDADDY broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch, remained forward entering the drive, drifted in mid stretch hitting the rail and lost rider.
