Footnotes

CHIEF JAY hustled up while moving to the rail to vie inside FIVE FOOT MIKE before the turn, shook clear nearing mid stretch, then proved best while kept to the task. FIVE FOOT MIKE angled in going to the turn to vie outside CHIEF JAY, could not keep pace inside the final furlong and then saved second. ANTSY AND POOR within striking distance, split foes around the turn, then lacked a final kick. TOP HOUR allowed to settle, came four wide around the turn, then could make little impact. NATBEA forwardly placed, weakened. GEARED DOWN LOW inside to the turn, moved out and then was no real threat. NOS VEMOS raced wide and improved position. ONESOCKMISSING was never dangerous. STORMSTER showed little. GERONIMO'S IMAGE showed early foot, moved to the rail, then dropped back. KAREN DROP was always outrun. SOUTHERN GROOM trailed.
