FAST FASHION vied for the lead, got headed approaching the drive, shook clear a furlong out and then was no match late. BRAX LEE'S TOY raced wide and was along for the show. MR. EXCELLENT vied for the lead, gained the edge around the turn and then faltered inside the final furlong. J C AND ME close up for a half, faded. CRO DOME was always outrun. PARADE DANCER well back from early on, lugged out around the turn and was eased.
