GALLOPING HOME settled inside from early on, advanced around the second turn, eased out after entering the drive, rallied determinedly and got up late. CLASSY DEELITES vied outside PANTARA PHANTOM early, got clear after entering the backstretch, repulsed a bid by WARREN'S MARK before the drive, opened up nearing mid stretch, then could not hold on. CAJUN CONQUEST unhurried, rallied outside but was too late. LEE'S SAY SO within striking distance, loomed three wide approaching the drive, then failed to sustain hid bid. GOWDEN MILE reserved early, rallied inside and hung. TRACK RECORD was never dangerous. SALIC LAW unhurried, loomed four wide nearing the drive, then flattened out. CODE RUNNER was always outrun. WARREN'S MARK forwardly placed, bid outside CLASSY DEELITES nearing the drive, then stopped. PANTARA PHANTOM vied inside CLASSY DEELITES early, then retreated.
